**Today's Bulletin Cover** features Antal Ligeti (1823-1890), a Hungarian landscape painter who completed this painting, *Nazareth* in 1862. Antal was expected to follow in the family's footsteps and become a merchant, but he was so intent on being an artist that he abandoned the comforts of home and went to Italy. Upon returning home he moved to Pest, where he obtained the patronage of Count István Károlyi, who's financial support allowed him to travel extensively; visiting Egypt, Palestine, Syria, Cyprus and Malta and returning with a huge portfolio of sketches, which he used as the subjects for paintings. Eventually, he was appointed curator of the art gallery at the Hungarian National Museum.

**Prayer after each worship service is available** in the prayer room off of the Narthex. Our Congregational Care Ministers and retired clergy are available to pray with you.






### GATHERINGS FOR CHILDREN
