



Today's Bulletin Cover features a 3rd-century fresco from the Catacombs of Priscilla in Rome, an underground burial place where early Christians expressed their faith and hope. This ancient image, painted on the ceiling of a family tomb room (cubiculum), depicts a shepherd in a white tunic with purple stripes—ordinary clothing marked by royal color, symbolizing both humanity and divine authority. The shepherd carries a rescued sheep and extends an open, welcoming hand, while nearby sheep and doves with olive branches evoke peace and community. Echoing Psalm 23, this scene suggests a guiding presence who seeks, carries, and sustains us even in life's darkest valleys.
