
Today's Bulletin Cover features *Christ Taking Leave of the Apostles* (1308–1311) by Duccio di Buoninsegna, a panel from his monumental Maestà altarpiece for Siena Cathedral in Italy. In this quiet scene, Jesus speaks his final words to the eleven disciples—Judas already absent—preparing them for a future they do not yet understand. Duccio leaves out halos to avoid crowding the space, allowing the soft drapery and gentle gestures to carry the emotional weight. The half-open door behind Christ casts a dark, uncertain void, a powerful symbol of absence, transition, and possibility. What will they do without him? The scene invites humility—not just from the disciples, but from us—as we acknowledge that understanding often comes slowly, and only by the Spirit's patient, guiding grace.

Prayer after each worship service is available in the prayer room off of the Narthex. Our Congregational Care Ministers and retired clergy are available to pray with you.


