Today's Bulletin Cover features El Greco's *Pentecost*, housed in Madrid's Museo del Prado. It vividly portrays the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Virgin Mary and the Apostles. The elongated bodies and flickering gestures evoke tongues of flame, linking the figures themselves to the miracle of speech. Their hands encircle the scene in a shared posture of awe, suggesting both communion and understanding. The dove descends from above, its light drawing the scattered into unity. This work, typical of El Greco's late style, uses distortion and dramatic color to express spiritual intensity and power.

This summer when there is more time to think; spend time with a small group of 3-4 people, who can support you in your spiritual growth.






