**Today's Bulletin Cover** features *Jesus* and the One Leper Who Returned to Give Thanks by William Brassey Hole (1846–1917), an English-born, Edinburgh-based painter, etcher, and illustrator who became a member of the Royal Scottish Academy. Celebrated in Scotland for his vast mural friezes, Hole also turned late in life to biblical subjects, traveling to Palestine to render the Gospels with greater authenticity. This image comes from his eighty-piece series The Life of Jesus of Nazareth, where naturalistic colors, strong lines, and carefully observed setting bring Luke's story to life and focus our attention on the lone figure who turns back in gratitude.

As we explore the prayers and habits God calls us to release in order to grow in faith, we also consider how we might outgrow fear, pride, or hesitation in order to grow into a deeper relationship with God through our generosity.
