

Today's Bulletin Cover features *The Prodigal Son* by Swiss painter Eugène Burnand, an artist of the late 19th and early 20th centuries known for his detailed realism and deeply sympathetic portrayals of biblical stories. Trained in Geneva and Paris, Burnand combined academic technique with a tender eye for human emotion. In this work, the father stands on a balcony, gazing into the distance as he waits, hopes, and longs for his son's return. The stillness of his figure conveys both the ache of absence and the steadfastness of love. The image invites us to see in the father's watchfulness a glimpse of God's own mercy and patience.
